Parkinson's is a complex, progressive condition with a wide range of symptoms, including:



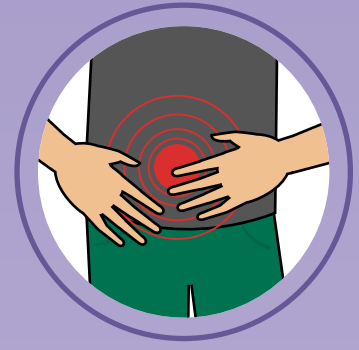
Movement challenges

No cure exists, but different treatments are approved to treat symptoms like:



Dyskinesia

Abnormal, uncontrollable and involuntary movements



OFF time

When symptoms return, often because medication has worn off



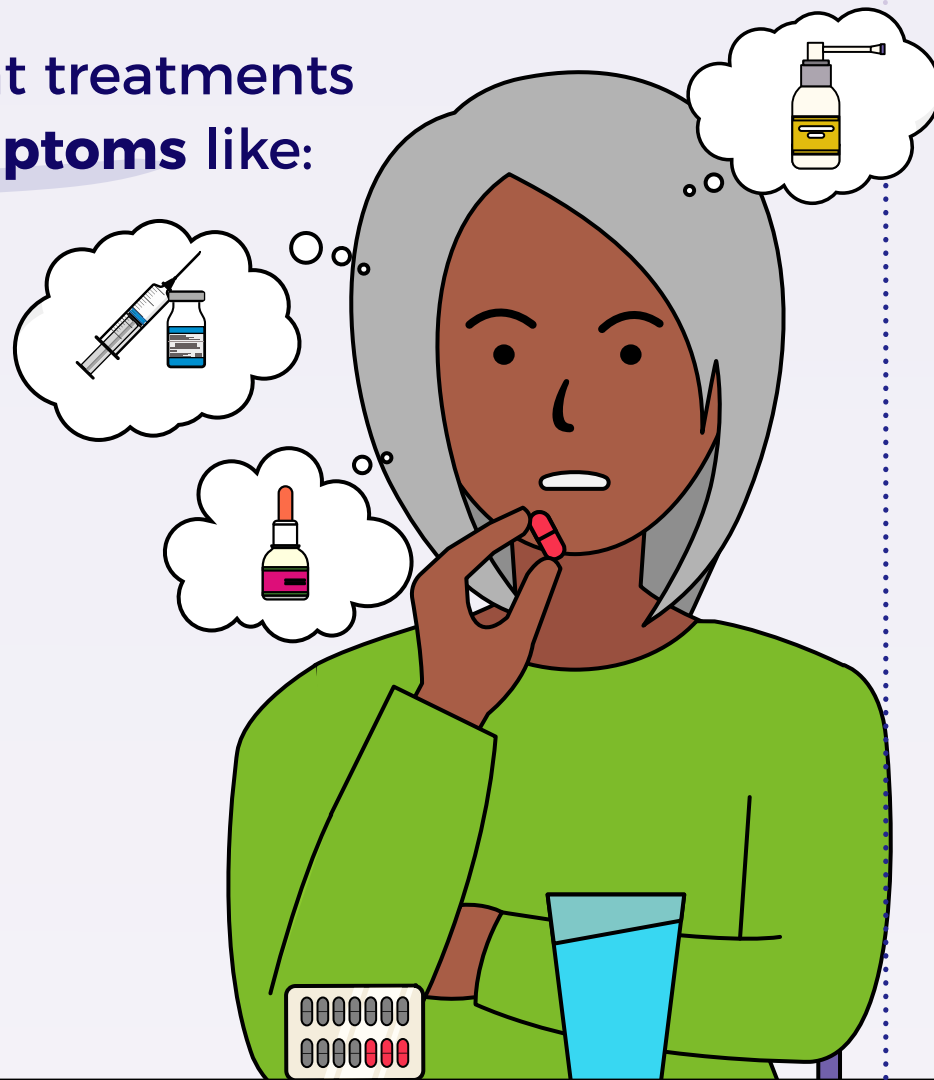
Psychosis

A non-motor symptom that causes hallucinations or delusions



Movement challenges

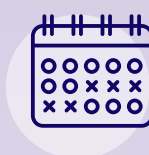
Loss of control, slow movements and rigid muscles
